Regular Scheduled Meeting of May 12th, 2005

The Meeting of the Point Roberts Water District No. 4 Board of Commissioners was called to order at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Anderson, Johnson, Wilkowski and Manager Bourks. Guests included Margaret Moras, Bruno Moras and Doug Ritchie.

- 1. MINUTES: A motion was made by Commissioner Wilkowski to approve the minutes of the Special Scheduled Meeting of April 11th, 2005. The motion seconded by Commissioner Johnson, passed unanimously. A motion was made by Commissioner Wilkowski and seconded by Commissioner Johnson to approve the minutes of the Special Scheduled Meeting of April 26th, 2005. The motion passed.
- **2. GUESTS AND COMMENTS:** A motion was made by Commissioner Wilkowski and seconded by Commissioner Johnson to approve moving the Guests and Comments segment of the meeting from the No. 5 position to No. 2 position on the Agenda. The motion passed.
 - 1. Doug Ritchie wants to see the cash invested on a regular basis.
 - 2. Bruno Moras was representing some of the residents of Marina Estates. They are concerned about Lot #34 which is not entitled to sewer hookup as it was subdivided after the initial development was created. They would be willing to contact residents in the area regarding payment of a surcharge to connect this lot to sewer.
 - 3. Lot #19 of Marina Yacht Basin was from 1984 2001 zoned as Urban Residential
 3. In 2001, a change was made to Recreational Zoning. With this change in
 zoning the Marina has transferred two of its connections for sewer to this lot. The
 lot now has 3 water and sewer connections allocated to it. Some of the
 residents of Marina Estates feel it is the Water District's
 responsibility to sort out the conflict between the homeowners and the
 purchaser of Lot #19.

The Marina organization has given up two of its sewer allotments for Lot #19.

Our Attorney is to be contacted regarding the above matters and will advise the Water District.

3. <u>VOUCHERS:</u> Commissioner Wilkowski moved to accept the Vouchers for May 2005 in the amount of \$58,256.75. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed.
