#### **MINUTES**

A letter, signed by the Board, is being sent.

# 8. **NEW BUSINESS**:

A. Commissioner Meursing moved to rescind from Section F of Resolution No. 538, the following:

In addition, if renewal of water service at the particular location is requested by the original customer, a \$50.00 reconnection fee will be charged, plus monthly charges back to the beginning of the current billing year (January 1<sup>st</sup>).

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson and passed.
